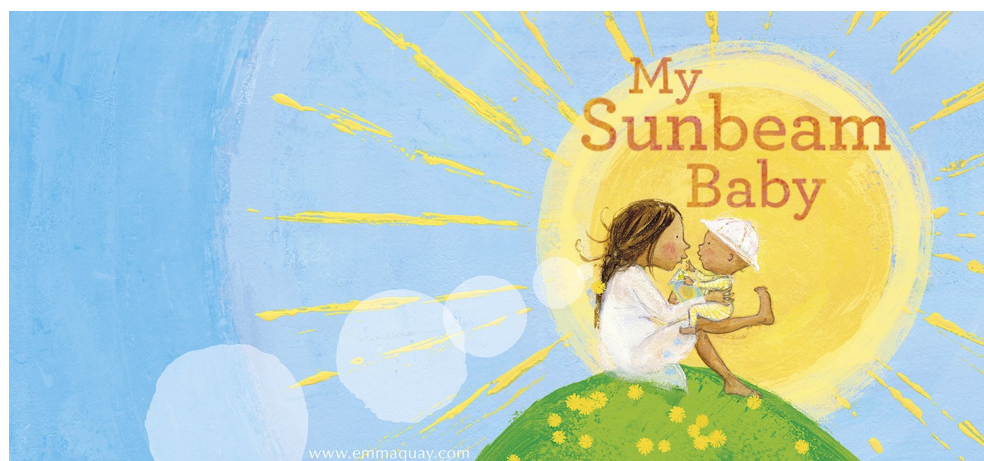

Babies

Bring in a photo of yourself (teacher) as a baby or have one scanned to display on a screen in the classroom.



Ask other key teachers (principal/librarian/Specialist Teacher) that your students know for their baby photos. Have them all on display.

Ask the student to have a look at the photos and see if they know who they are.

Ask each child to bring in a photo of themselves as a baby (make sure they're labelled on the back)

Either display those in the classroom or scan them and display.

See if the students can recognise each other as babies. How have they changed? How are they the same?

Discuss how much they have grown since they were babies, and make a list of all of the things they can do now that they couldn't do when they were babies.
