Pre Reading

Before reading the book, look at the end papers. What is the illustration on the end papers. (front only)

Have you ever seen the ground dry and cracked during a drought? What other visible signs could we expect to see during a drought?

Read the book.

After reading the book, ask the questions:

What is a drought?

How are people's everyday lives affected by drought? (Read Jackie's note in the back of the book where she shares some of the comments she has heard from kids living through drought)

How might farming be affected by drought?

Obviously the weather events are different, but after sharing the books ask whether they can see similarities between the titles.








Another text to use as a comparison is **MY COUNTRY** by Dorothy McKellar.
