

What do you think makes a good cover?


Design new cover and back cover for your favourite book. Either drawing or using design software.

# **Writing**

There are two names on the cover of the book.

Two names on the front of a picture book usually indicates the author and the illustrator.

This is not the case here. Why would there be two names on the front?

- Discuss how you think two people would write a novel together.
- Do you think it would be easy or difficult.

James Patterson provides his co-authors with an extensive ideas, outlines and notes, and they then write the story.

- Divide the class into pairs
- Choose one child write the ideas, plot, storyline (1 page)
- The other child then writes the story (2 pages)

When the story is written have the 'ideas writer' read the story that was created from their ideas. Did they like it. Was it what they imagined, Would they have written a different kind of story?

Ask the 'story writers' if they found it difficult to write a story from someone else's ideas and notes?

Some co-authored books are written by the authors writing alternate chapters each.


Write a story of four parts.

Person 1: Starts the story

Person 2: Reads the first part, writes the second part.

Person 1 : Continues the story Person 2: Finishes the story.

It could be a serious story or something funny, like the stories made up in *Mixed Up Fairy Tales* by Hilary Robinson and Nick Sharratt.
