- BUILD A BOO!


Get crafty and create your very own Boo, just like Dimple's mischievous friend in Dimple and the Boo!

- PVA glue





1. Use the template to cut out two identical cardboard discs. Ask an adult for help.




TOP TIP: Make sure you cut out the slit and middle circle, it should look like a small doughnut.


3. Start wrapping the wool all around the edges, feeding the wool through the gap each time.



5. Snip the end of the wool and then cut an extra length of wool about 25cm long.




2. Place the templates together, but do not glue them.




TOP TIP: Make sure the hole and gap match up.

4. Keep wrapping until you have nearly run our of space on your cardboard template.




6. Hold the middle of your pom pom and carfully use your scissors to cut all around the edge, between the two templates.




TOP TIP: Make sure you get every piece of wool.

7. Place your extra length of wool between the two templates all the way round, and tie tightly to secure.




8. You can now remove your cardboard template and fluff up the wool to reveal your finished Boo.



 Bend and cut your pipe cleaners into some shapes for the arms, legs, eyebrows and of course smile.




10. Use PVA to stick on the googly eyes and pipe cleaners to add character to your Boo!
