POLLY'S EASY PEASY FAIRY BREAD RECIPE

Make a batch of one of Polly's favourite party snacks and share with friends!





Equipment

Butter Knife Cutting Knife Chopping Board Rimmed Tray (optional - see Tip)

Ingredients

8 slices of white bread

1/4 cup softened butter

1/4 cup 100s and 1000s/ multicoloured sprinkles!

Instructions

1. Gather the ingredients.

- Butter one side of each slice of bread. Make sure to spread it all the way to the edges.
- 3. Coat the entire buttered side with plenty of sprinkles.
- 4. Finally, cut each slice of bread at an angle to form triangles.
- 5. Enjoy!

<u>Tip</u>

To prevent sprinkles from escaping and rolling everywhere, place the buttered bread slices inside a rimmed tray before coating in sprinkles.

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MAKE A PINATA JUST LIKE MAE

If you'd like to make a horse like Mae, use the template on the following pages. Scale-up if you want to make it bigger.

Alternatively, you can choose any shape you'd like. Keep it simple if this is your first one.



You will need

Scissors

Masking Tape

Glue Stick or Hot Glue

Flat cardboard like an old box (a cereal box or tow will do)

Tissue Paper in chosen colours (crepe paper streamers work too)

String for a hanging loop

Treats to fill it with (eq. lollies, stickers, party favours, confetti)

How To Make

MAKE YOUR PIÑATA SHAPE

Step 1. Draw your shape onto the flat cardboard twice, and then cut them out into two identical pieces.


Step 2. Cut 6cm wide strips down the remaining length of the cardboard until you have enough to run the entire edge of your flat shape. Tape together to form one long strip.

Step 3. Use tape to attach the strip to the sides of each flat shape. Continue folding it around the entire edge, securing it with tape until you reach where you started. Before joining the two ends together with tape, fill your shape with your chosen treats!



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
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DECORATE YOUR PIÑATA

Step 4. Cut the tissue paper into strips approximately 4cm wide.

Step 5. Cut slits halfway through one edge of each strip to create a fringe.

Step 6. Using glue, attach the tissue paper strips to your shape. Start at the bottom and work your way up to the top. Use a layer or two of flat tissue paper on cardboard surfaces that are tricky to cover, like underneath your shape.


Step 7. Trim any excess fringe areas and attach a tail, ears, eyes or other decorations you'd like to add. Make these from leftover cardboard or use coloured paper.


FINISHING YOUR PIÑATA

Step 8. Using the tip of the scissors, poke two small holes into the centre-top area of your shape. Thread string through the holes and tie the ends to make a secure loop.

TA-DA! Your pinata is now ready to be hung and used.
