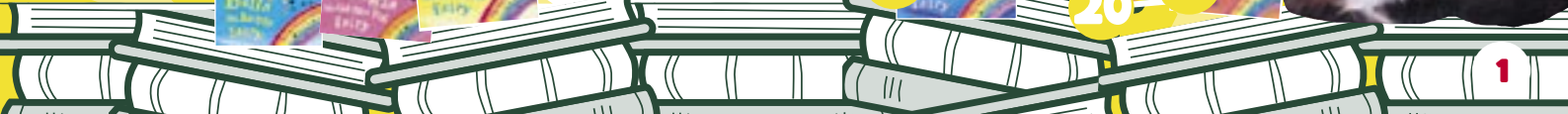
New Releases
