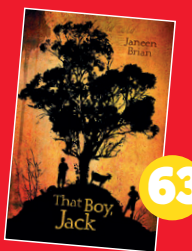
62. Stage School: Olivia and the Great Escape (Lyn Gardner) \$14.95

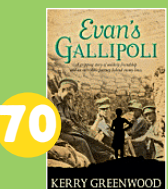
67. Big Dry, The (Tony Davis) \$15.95

68. Chasing the Valley (Skye Melki Wegner) \$17.95
Set in a land where magic can be terrifying, Chasing the Valley combines the friendship and camaraderie of Ranger's Apprentice with the hardship and survival of The Hunger Games - with spectacular results. Danika is used to struggling for survival. 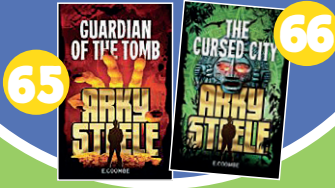
75. Spy Society (Robin Benway) \$12.95

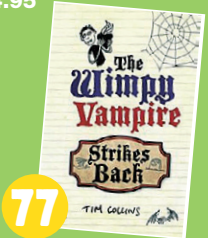

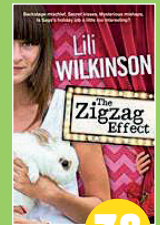
77. Wimp Vampire Strikes Back, The (Tim Collins) \$14.95
