We're all living together now-black and white, we gotta get along.

26. Bog Frog Hop (Kyle Mewburn and Rebecca Cool)

Cut to 1989, when the lower leg bone of the little dinosaur was discovered by palaeontologists on the Otway coast of Victoria.






