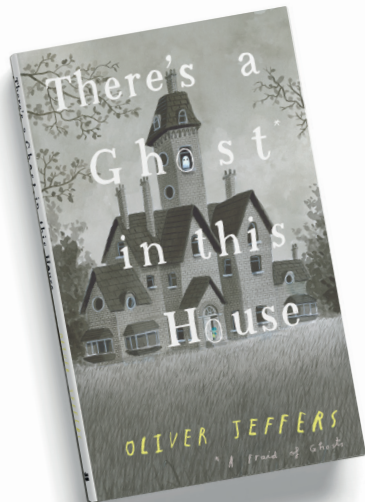

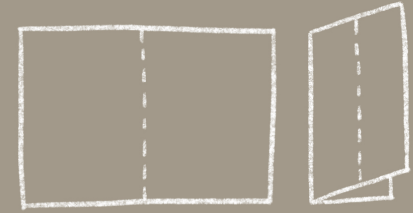
GHOST DECORATION TEMPLATE

4. Cut out the ghost and don't forget to add the face:



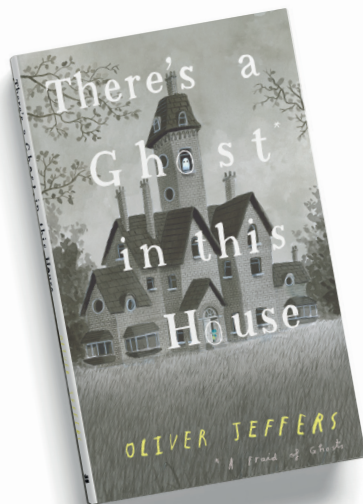

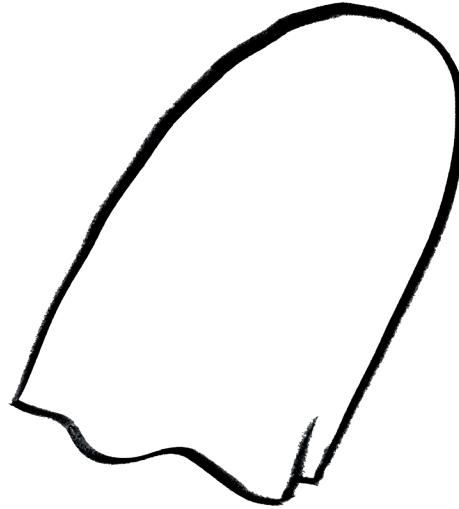
HOW TO DRAW A GHOST!

are floating.



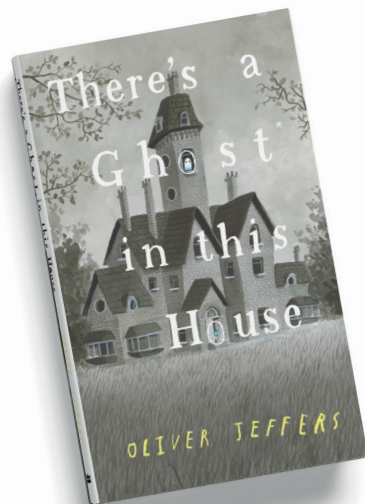

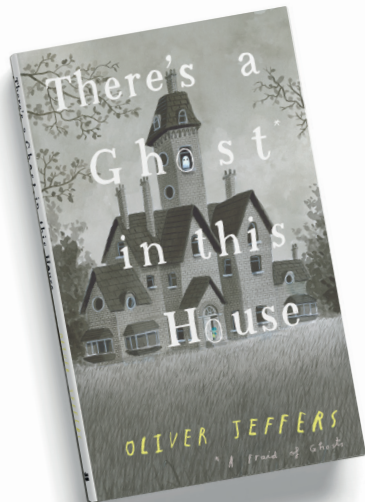

- white gloves

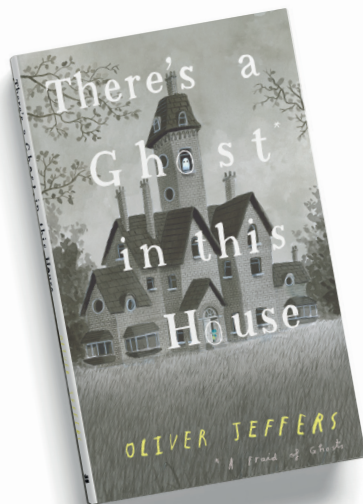

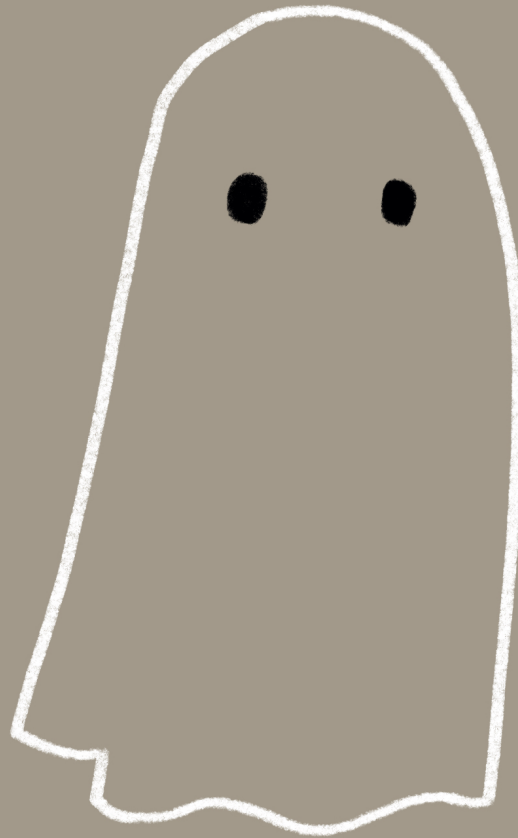
FUN HALLOWEEN RECIPE

Use the template to
cut out your ghost:



Ingredients:

flour tortillas or wraps,
olive oil, salt

Method:

Preheat the oven to 190C /
Gas 5.

Cut out the ghost template,
place it on your tortilla/wrap
and carefully cut around it.

Repeat until you can't cut
any more ghosts.

Brush each ghost with
olive oil and sprinkle with
a little salt.

Bake for 5-7 minutes and
serve with your choice of dip.



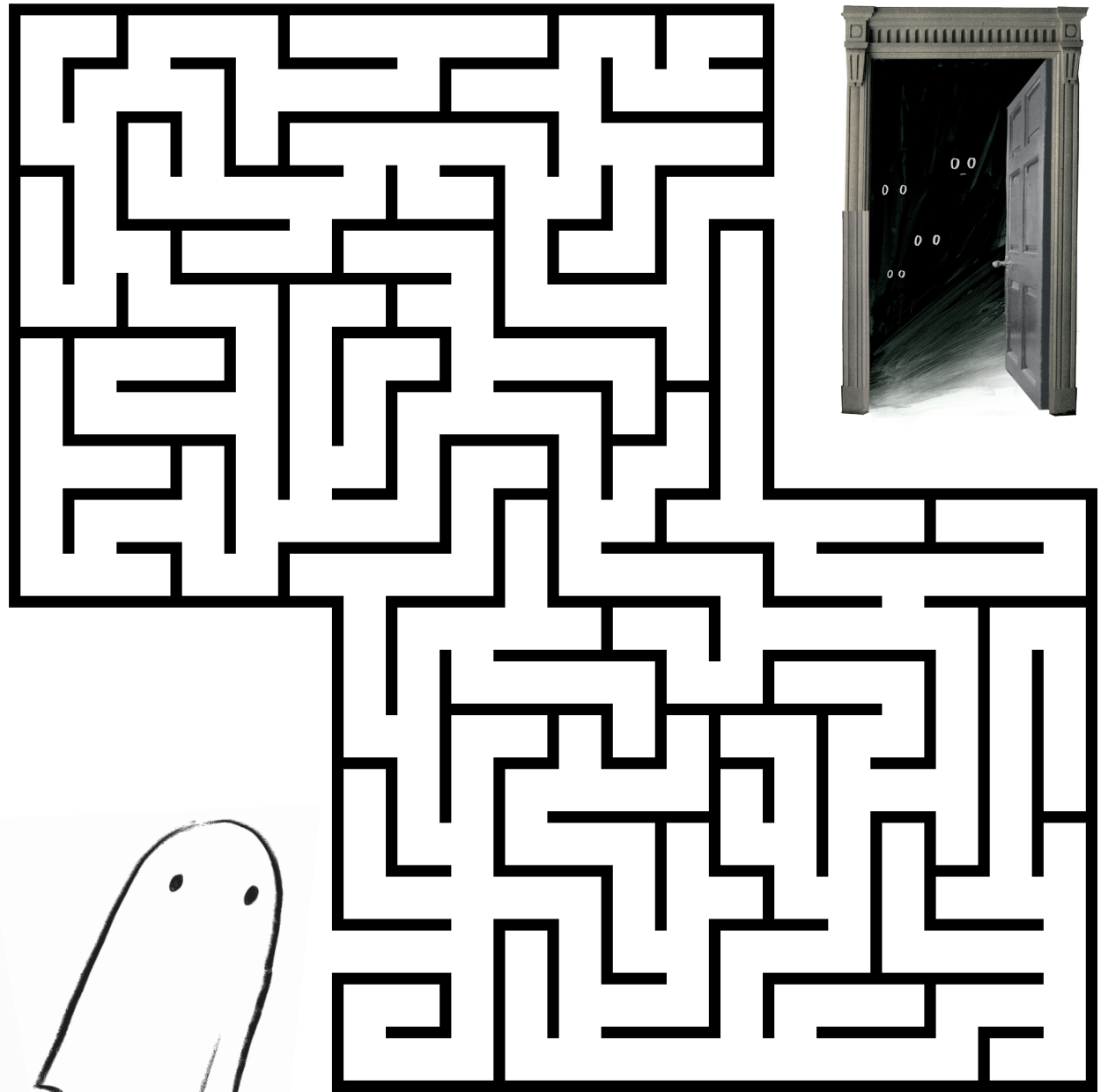
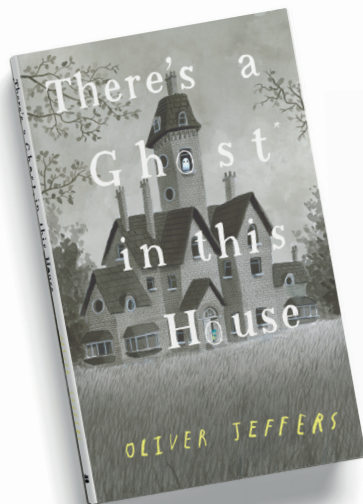

to its hiding place!



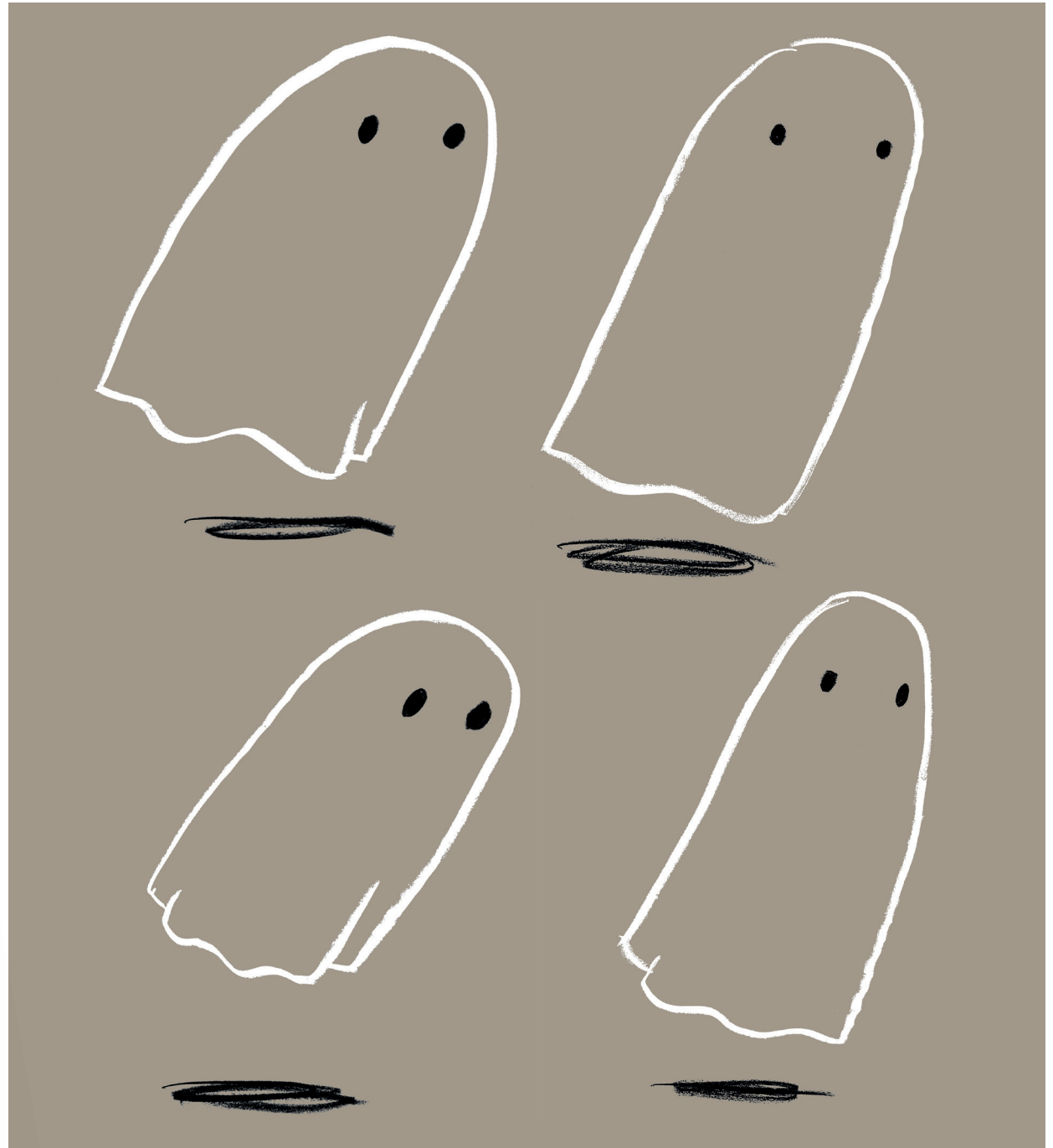
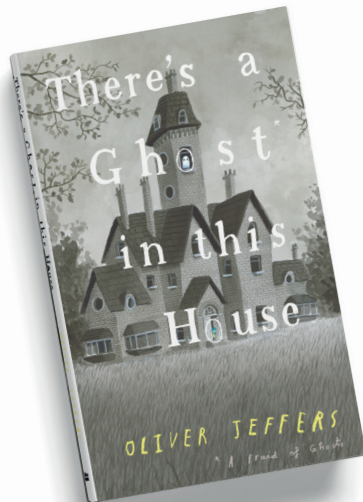

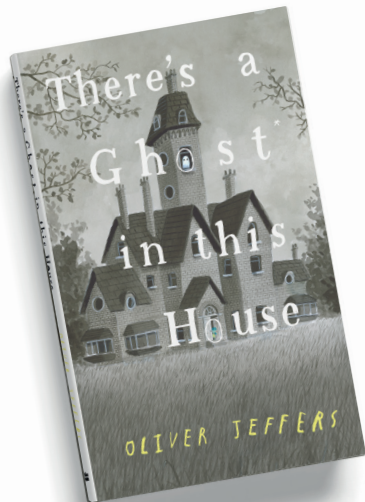
