## TRIANGLE

- ▲ After reading the story, discuss whether Square had planned all along to block Triangle's door.
- ▲ Ask students if they have ever played a sneaky trick on a friend or had a friend play one on them. How did it make them feel?
- ▲ Talk about the angles in each shape and why Square would not fit through Triangle's door. Is there any way for him to fit through?
- ▲ Have students pick different shapes and write a story using them as characters.
