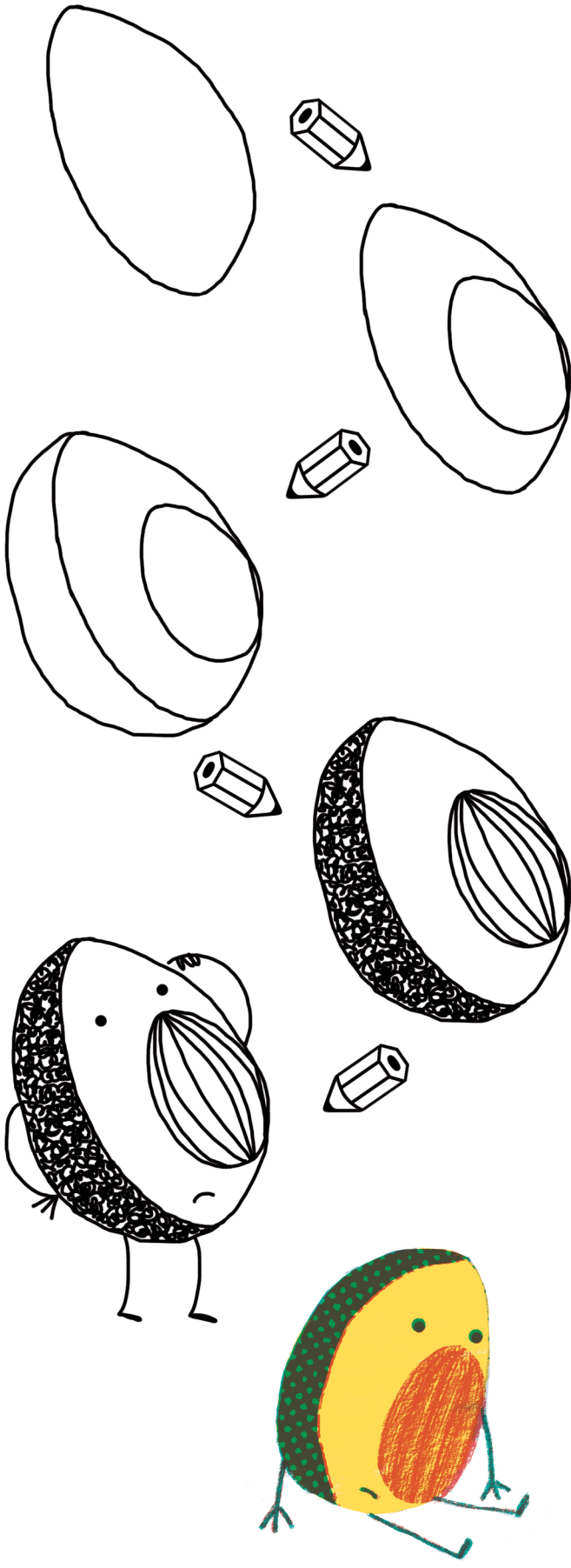


HOW TO DRAW AN AVOCADO CHARACTER

Follow these easy steps to draw an avocado character yourself!



① Draw a oval like an egg.

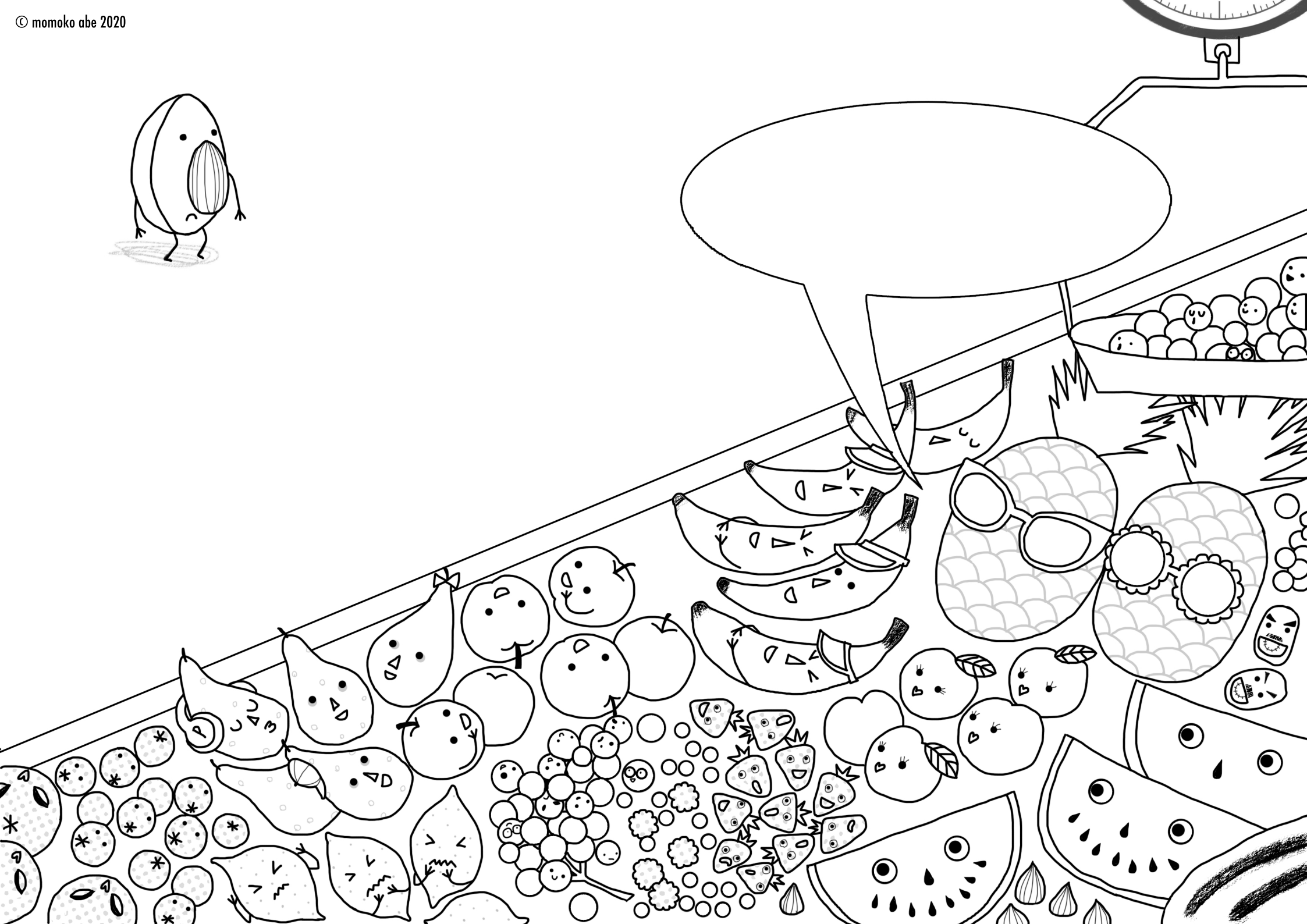
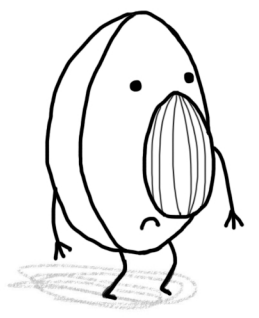
② Draw a smaller oval inside the bigger oval. This will be the pit/nose.

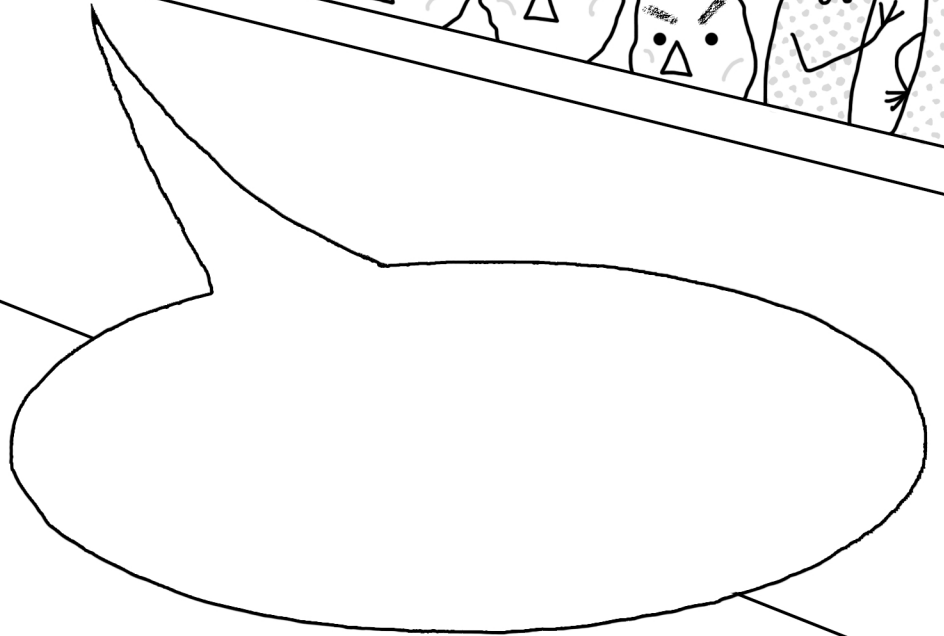
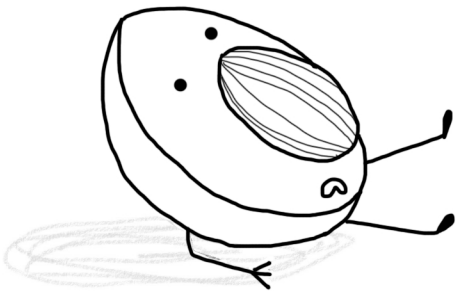
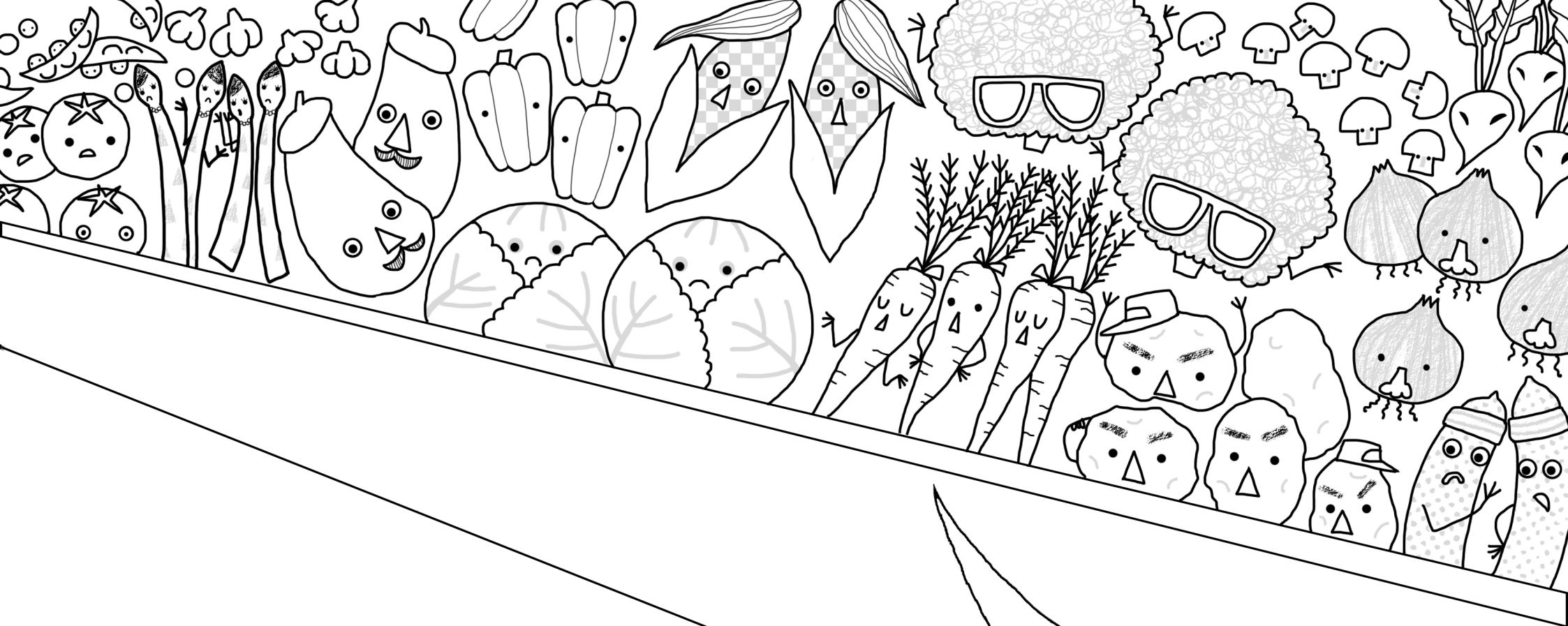
③ Add a curve for the skin (this creates 3D look).

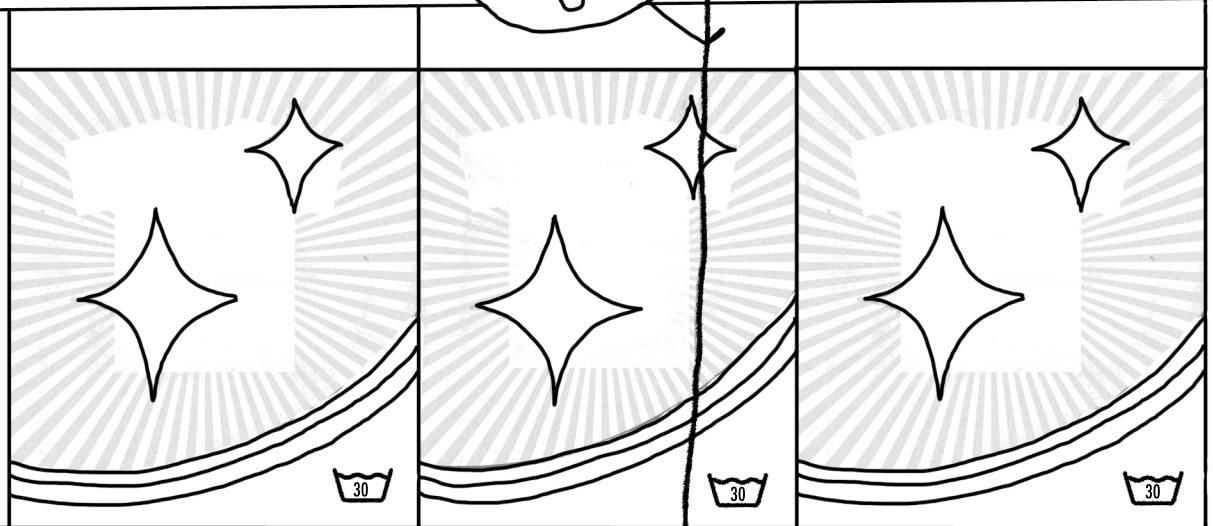
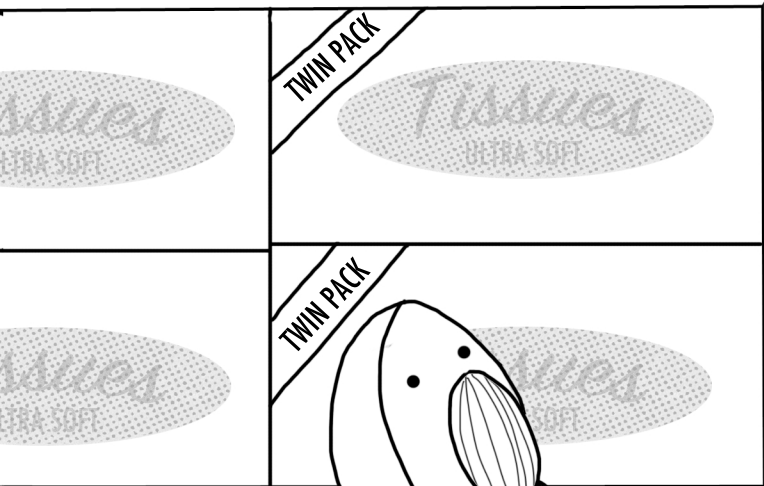
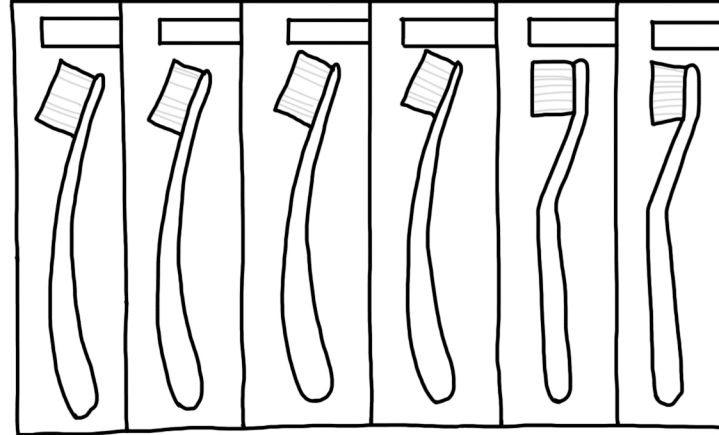
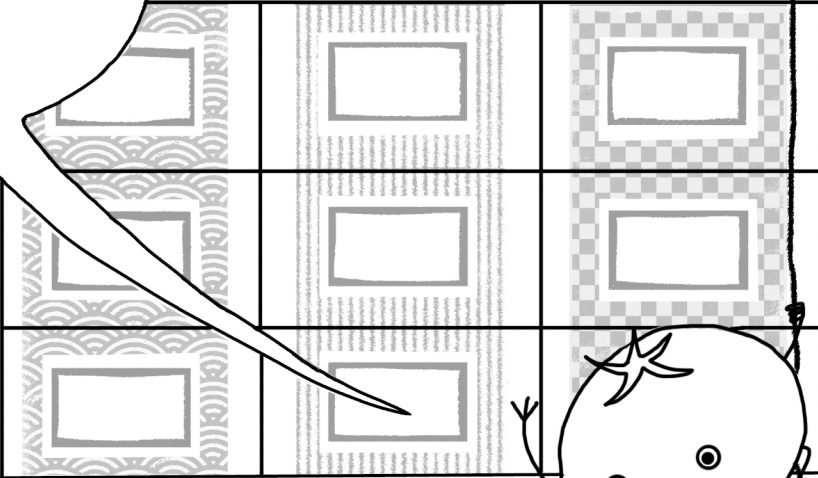
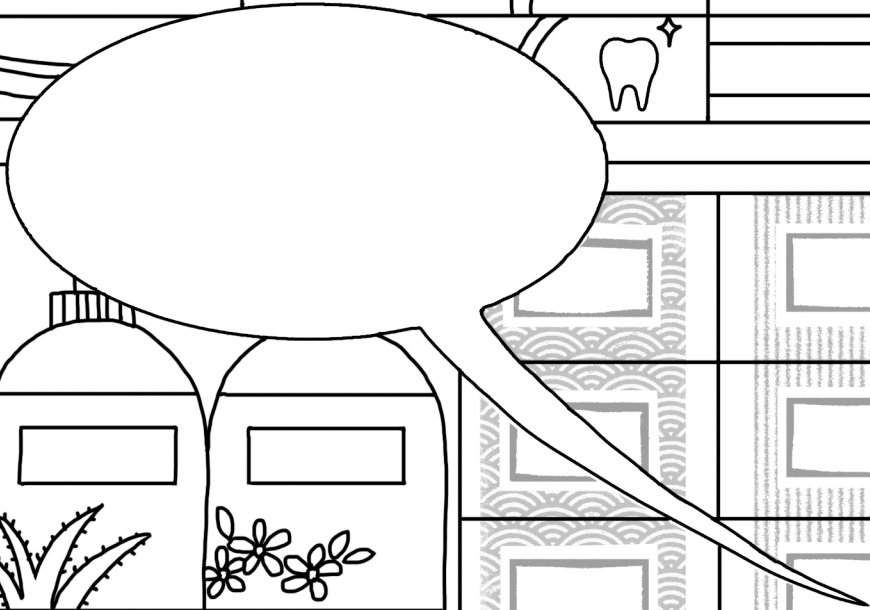
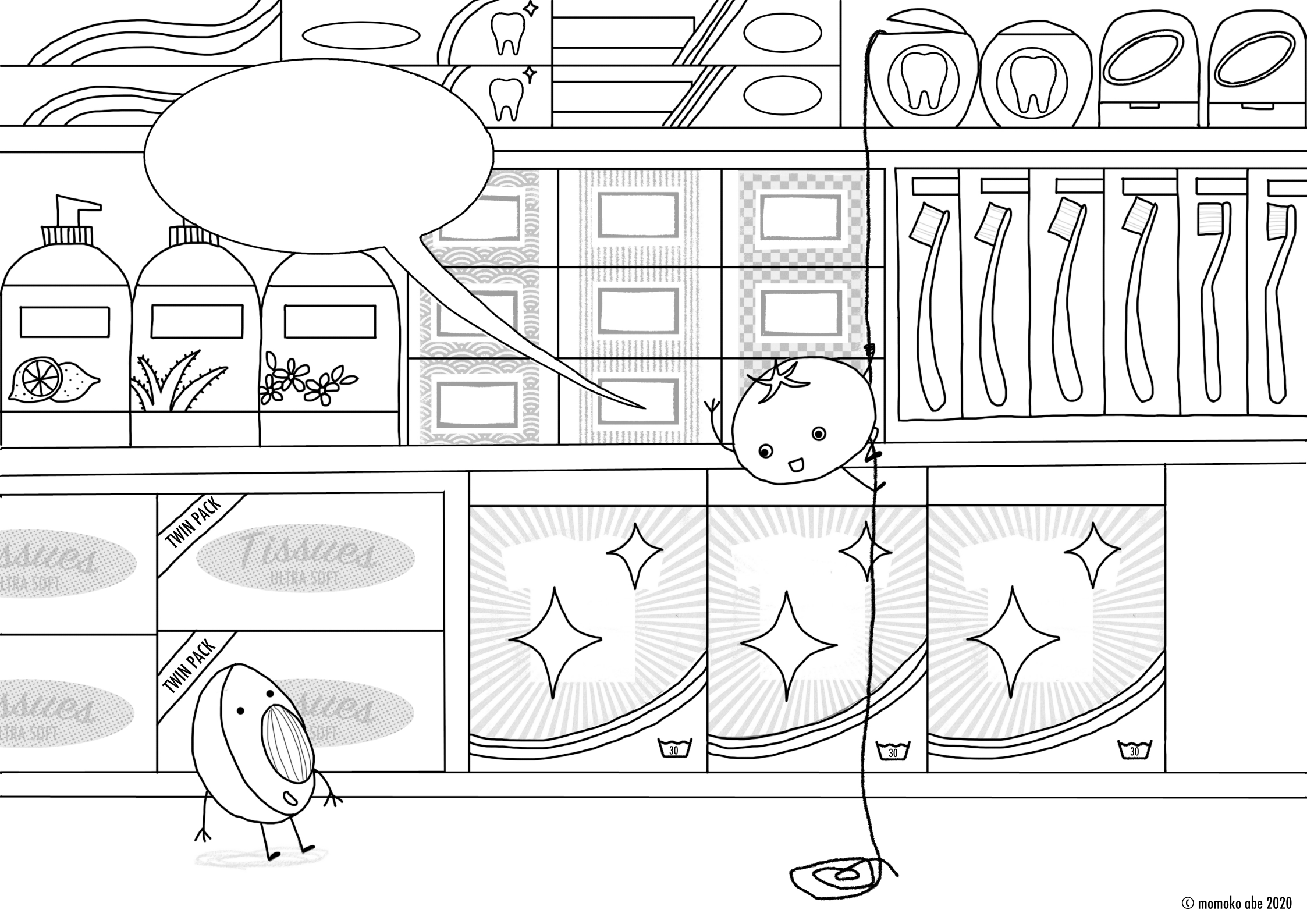
④ Add streaky lines to the pit and squiggly lines to the skin so it looks like an avocado.

⑤ Draw eyes, mouth, arms and legs. And there you have it. You drew an avocado character!

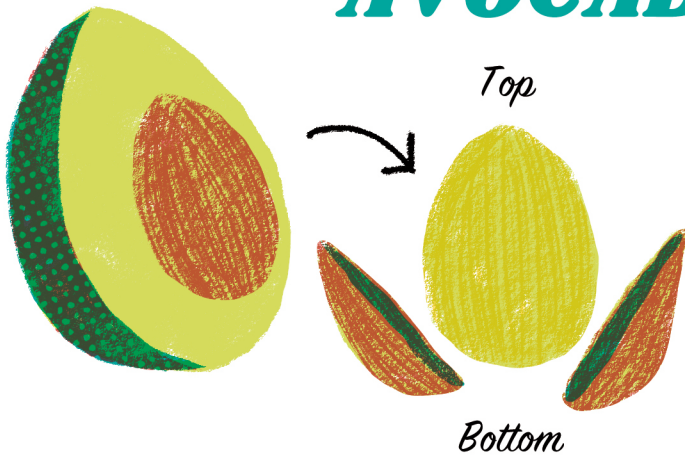
You can try different expressions and gestures and make it your own!



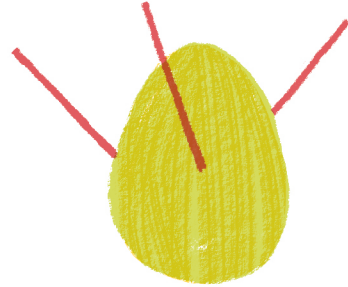




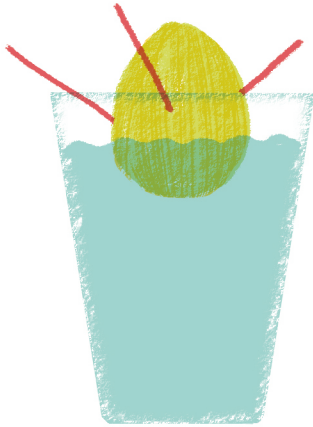
HOW TO GROW YOUR OWN AVOCADO TREE



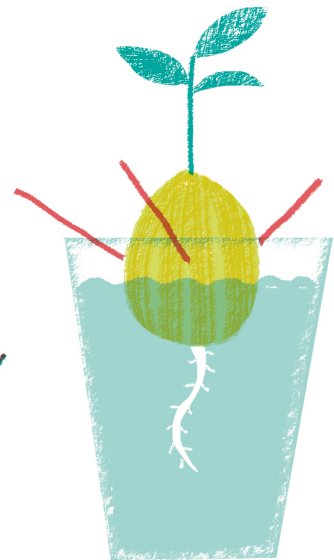
① Scoop out the pit from the avocado. Rinse and peel off the brown skin.



② Insert 3 toothpicks at a slight downward angle.



③ Place the pit half submerged in a glass of water. And set it on a sunny windowsill. Change water every 5-7 days.



④ Wait for 2-4 weeks for your pit to sprout.



⑤ Plant the pit in an pot filled with soil when the stem is about 6 inch tall, leaving the top half of the pit exposed. Place on a sunny windowsill and water regularly (the soil should always be moist).
