- Look at Enter the Roo: Kung Fu Roo I's cover. Who do you think the story will be about? Can you find any clues on the cover that remind you of kung fu? [Hint:Think about where kung fu originates, then look at the font used in the words Kung Fu Roo, the framing around the image of the three

characters and the background colours of gold and red]. Can you find a kangaroo on the cover? What sort of story — adventure, science fiction, historical fiction or fairytale — might you expect from what you can see on the cover? Does the cover make you want to open the book?

- ★ In a graphic novel, a long shot shows the whole scene.
  A medium shot shows part of the scene, usually

focusing on the characters from the waist up, while a close-up zooms in on something important, like a character's face or an object. Find an example of each of these shots in Chapter Three.





- Lines and shapes communicate ideas in graphic novels, too. Turn to page 52 and look at the lines around Kai after he jumps and lands on the grass. What do these lines tell us about his landing? Can you find other examples of lines or shapes playing a similar role later in this chapter?
- ★ Changes in time and position can also be shown by illustrating different stages of a movement within one panel, making it look like the character is in motion. Can you find an example of this happening in Chapter Four?
- The term 'panel' is used in graphic novels to describe each sequential image and its accompanying words. Panels are often similar in size but can be bigger or smaller at points as another way to tell the story. Look at each of the full-page panels in Chapter Six and see if you can come up with a reason for why they are larger than the other panels in the chapter.
- ★ Onomatopoeia is when words sound like their meanings for example CRUNCH, BUMP and CRASH on pages 106 and 108. Graphic novels often portray onomatopoeic words in a different way to the other text on a page. How are these words presented on the page to emphasise the drama of what is happening?
- ★ Foreshadowing in a graphic novel is when the story gives hints or clues about something that will happen later, like when a character finds something that reminds them of somebody important from their past. Can you find an example of foreshadowing in the final chapter? What do you think Kai's discovery could mean later in the story?
